



## FEES AND SUNDRY CHARGES

At Bishop Druit College we pride ourselves on offering a wide array of opportunities for our students to experience. As with all independent schools, the funds to provide those opportunities are met by government funding and your tuition fees.

### TUITION FEES

Primary	K-6	\$1,621 per term
Secondary	7-10	\$2,212 per term
Senior Secondary	11	\$2,370 per term
Senior Secondary	12	\$3,160 per term*

*\*Note: Year 12 is billed over 3 terms only.*

To support families, Bishop Druit College Council will maintain the discount program for 2017. Please note payments can only be made via the MyBDC Parent Lounge to attract the discount.

#### A. Annual Upfront Payment - 3.5% Discount

Make one annual payment for the 2017 tuition fees including any outstanding balance by 30 November 2016 to receive a full 3.5% discount.

#### B. Term-Based Early Payment - 2% Discount

Make each 2017 term payment by the dates below to receive a 2% discount. Note: each payment must include any outstanding balance to attract the discount. The due dates for advance payments each term are:

Term 1: 10 December 2016

Term 2: 10 March 2017

Term 3: 10 June 2017

Term 4: 10 September 2017

### MYBDC PARENT LOUNGE

The Parent Lounge is specifically tailored for parents and caregivers. It offers access to the student timetable, school calendar, student diary, daily notices and academic reports. Parents and caregivers are also able to pay school accounts, view monthly statements, give permission for excursions, and book parent-teacher interviews.

Parent Lounge is available for you to access upon acceptance of your enrolment application.

To ensure that the collection of payments from 2017 onwards is as streamlined as possible, we will only be collecting tuition fee payments through the Parent Lounge.

### PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR 2017

#### A. 3.5% Discount on Annual Tuition Fees (if paid by 30 November 2016)

The full 2017 annual fee statement is currently in the Parent Lounge. Paying all tuition fees by 30 November 2016 will attract a 3.5% discount if made in one payment and must include any outstanding balance from 2016.

#### B. 2% Discount on Term 1 Tuition Fees (if paid in full by 10 December 2016)

On 1 December, the Term 1 fees will be posted into the Parent Lounge to allow parents to opt to pay Term 1 in advance by 10 December 2016 to receive a 2% discount. One payment for all Term 1 fees is required and must also include any outstanding

balance from 2016 to attract the discount. Terms 2, 3 and 4 will follow throughout the year, as previously noted.

## C. Fortnightly Payments

A fortnightly payment plan (over 22 fortnights) is also available. Payments must commence on 10 December. Please contact the finance team to set this arrangement up. There are no early payment discounts applicable if you choose this option.

# SUNDRY CHARGES

**Bishop Druitt College always attempts to contain fees to minimise the financial burden on our parents. However, it is not possible to make a general provision for all activities. Therefore, we have determined that a number of additional fees may apply from time to time for the provision of services or activities that are in addition to normal classroom tuition. Where specific costs are met on behalf of the student we will utilise our online payments system to collect these funds. Where it is not possible to use the online system, parents will be provided with a sundry account. Parents are advised of activities and provided with information on how to pay as they occur.**

## ACTIVITY PAYMENTS

The college uses an online payment system to allow parents to make payments for excursions, sport, cultural trips, in-house presentations, instrumental music tuition and other educational expenses via the Parent Lounge.

## PRIMARY STUDENTS

### Compulsory Charges

During the year, primary students undertake a number of compulsory activities requiring extra charges. This includes, but is not limited to: Athletics, Reading Eggs, local sports carnivals, term sport, Foundation Day and end of year activities, shows, etc.

### Optional Charges

The college prides itself on offering many extracurricular activities. A wide variety of optional activities are offered (at an extra cost). Parents will be advised during the course of the year about what activities are available and the cost. Parents can then decide what extra activities they would like their child to undertake.

Other activities may include, but are not limited to:

ACER exams, various sporting events and excursions such as basketball, soccer, rugby, athletics and cross country. Non sport options include chess, school band, musical instrument hire &

lessons, leadership conference, Athletics for younger students, class photo, Mother's & Father's Day gift, music eisteddfods, etc.

## Out of School Hours Care and Vacation Care

Bishop Druitt College Outside of School Hours Care (OSHC) offers centre-based care for children aged 5-14 years for after school during school term and all day during the school holidays. ## Primary Camps

Camps are held for Years 3 and 5. Costs are notified near the time of each camp and paid separately by parents. The college works hard to keep the cost down. The costs of these camps are payable prior to attending each camp, using our on-line payments system.

## SECONDARY STUDENTS

### Annual Subject Fees

Subject fees are charged for many elective secondary subjects. These costs are charged for each subject to cover various school activities and use of materials/resources. Indicative costs per subject per year group are attached for the information of parents and caregivers. These fees are dependent on individual student's subject selection. Subjects may change from year to year.

### Other Compulsory Fees

In addition to subject fees there are also other fees applicable during the year. These are variable and depend on what opportunities arise during the year for the student. Parents will be notified of these charges over the course of the year. Examples include, but are not limited to: visiting artists and shows, external tests/exams, Foundation Day activities, sports carnivals, workshops, relaxation classes, etc.

### Optional Charges

The college prides itself on offering many extracurricular activities. A wide variety of optional activities are offered (at an extra cost). Parents will be advised during the course of the year about what activities are available and the cost, as part of the participation permission process.

Other activities include, but are not limited to:

Various sporting events and excursions such as skiing, basketball, soccer, rugby, athletics and cross country. Non sport options include overseas excursions, chess, musical instrument hire & lessons, music eisteddfod, excursions to Sydney for various subjects, school socials, university open days, some external exams/test, specialist lectures/workshops, school magazine, Tournament of Minds, Duke of Edinburgh, workbooks, etc.

## Monday Sport

Elective sports are offered each term. Specific costs are attached to each sport and are charged separately following parental permission.

## Secondary Camps

School camps are an important and integral part of the education of our students. We understand the financial impact this has on families and, accordingly, the charge for these compulsory secondary camps is included in the school tuition fees.
