ATSI Scholarship

A limited number of scholarships are available for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students across the college from Kindergarten to Year 11. These scholarships are for students who wish to complete their education at BDC.

Candidates must be able to provide evidence of a good attitude to studies, have an excellent attendance record, and must display a willingness to participate in the wider life of the college. Latest NAPLAN results and school reports will be considered.

Application Guidelines

Process: Application and possible interview.
Award: Full or partial.
Deadline for applications: Applications close at end of Term 1.

Any scholarship awarded supersedes any existing discount, such as a sibling discount. Concessions are NOT cumulative. Whichever is the greater applies.

Short-listed applicants may be invited to an interview with the Principal and the head of school. Scholarships are awarded by the Principal. The value of the scholarship is at the Principal's discretion.

Applicants should submit the following documents to the Principal by the end of Term 1:

- Completed scholarship application form.
- An introductory letter written by the student stating why they would like to attend Bishop Druitt College (if applicable) and why they would make a worthy candidate for this scholarship.
- Copies of the student's last two school reports.
- A copy of the most recent NAPLAN results.
- Two referee reports supporting your application for an ATSI scholarship at Bishop Druitt College, one of which should be from a local Aboriginal elder.
