All-Rounder Scholarships

A limited number of partial All-Rounder Scholarships are available to new or current BDC students from Year 5 to Year 12.

Applicants must have achieved to a very high level in their academic studies and in at least one co-curricular endeavour. As an indicative measure, a student should have represented at least at **state level** or equivalent in their co-curricular field as a minimum. Latest NAPLAN results, supportive documentation and school reports will be considered.

Specific conditions considered in the annual review include the following:

- Students are expected to maintain their strong academic ability and continue to perform to their ability in at least one co-curricular area.

Application Guidelines

Process: Application and possible interview with the Principal and the Head of either Primary or Secondary.
Award: Partial only.
Deadline for applications: Applications close at the end of Term 1.

Any scholarship awarded supersedes any existing discount, such as a sibling discount. Concessions are NOT cumulative. Whichever is the greater applies.

Short-listed applicants may be invited to an interview with the Principal and the head of school. Scholarships are awarded by the Principal. The value of the scholarship is at the Principal's discretion.

Applicants should submit the following documents to the Principal by the end of Term 1:

- Completed scholarship application form.
- An introductory letter written by the student stating why they would like to attend Bishop Druitt College (if applicable) and why they would make a worthy candidate for this scholarship.
- Copies of the student's last two school reports.
- A copy of the most recent NAPLAN results.
- Two current, relevant references supporting the application for a scholarship at Bishop Druitt College.
