BISHOP DRUITT COLLEGE VISUAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS 2012

The Bishop Drutt College Visual Arts Scholarships provide the opportunity for students to attend Bishop Drutt College in order to pursue their artistic talents in the Visual Arts field. The scholarship is offered to students in Year 10 who are either currently attending Bishop Drutt College or at another school.

The award is for up to 50% reduction in tuition fees and is valid for both Years 11 and 12 on the proviso that the scholarship holder maintains a keen interest in Visual Arts and achieves within the top 10% of the cohort in Visual Arts during Year 11.

Applicants are required to:

1. Complete the application form
2. Supply all support material
3. Attend an interview

Selection Criteria:

- Demonstrated standard of excellence in Visual Arts studies
- Personal qualities and career aspirations
- Demonstrated need for the scholarship
- Demonstrated academic excellence

Selection

- Applicants will be short listed on the basis of their application and support materials
- Applicants who are short listed will be asked to attend an interview
- Successful applicants will be selected by a committee comprising the Principal, Head of Visual Arts and the Director of Curriculum

SUPPORT MATERIAL

Applicants are requested to supply the following support material:

1. Up to ten images supporting your art practice. Digital images should be jpegs of no more than 1MB and submitted on a CD-ROM. Film work should be submitted as a QuickTime file and must be able to be viewed on Macintosh platform. Examples of works must be clearly documented, with your name, the title and media.

APPLICANTS SHOULD NOT SEND ORIGINAL ARTWORKS OR VISUAL ARTS PROCESS DIARIES.

2. The names of two referees - preferably persons who have know the applicant for some years in an academic relationship. At least one referee should be in a position, if requested, to verify the applicant's authorship of the works depicted in the visual documentation supplied with the application.
3. An artist's statement (600 words or less) that clearly describes:
 - A range of your artworks and your preferred medium
 - Your interests, notable artistic achievements including exhibitions and involvement in community art projects
 - How the scholarship will assist you personally and how you may see your involvement in future Bishop Druitt Visual Arts pursuits
4. Include copies of the two most recent school reports (Current BDC students do not need to enclose copies of school reports)
5. A short statement that outlines:
 - Your wider abilities, interests and school involvement (sport played, positions held, club membership, community service, etc.)
 - An indication of any financial or other family circumstances deemed relevant
 - Applicant's explanatory comments regarding his/her wish to attend Bishop Druitt College
