# Sporting Performance Scholarships

A limited number of full and partial Sporting Performance Scholarships are available at Bishop Druitt College. We realise that expenses relating to students travelling to ongoing sporting representative events and training can be significant.

Bishop Druitt College offers a high performance program which will allow for alterations to subject timetables and greater access to our training facilities for those looking to concentrate on sporting careers.

Scholarships are awarded by the Principal in consultation with the Head of Secondary and the Sports Administrator. Sporting Performance Scholarships are generally offered to students participating in one of the following sporting codes: basketball, netball, touch football, rugby union, rugby league, football (soccer), futsal, golf, equestrian, swimming, athletics, cross country, tennis, surf sports, triathlon or pentathlon.

A Sporting Performance Scholarship will only be awarded to a student who has a proven record of strong academic effort and positive involvement in the wider life of their school that complements their sporting achievements. Latest NAPLAN and school reports will be considered. Positive behaviour is an expectation for all students and is a requirement of scholarship holders.

Specific conditions considered in the annual review include the following:

- Students are expected to participate in and achieve ongoing high performance standards in their chosen sport at the time of entry, or an alternative sport as approved by the college.
- Students are expected to support college teams in a variety of sports and carnivals as nominated by the Head of Secondary and the Sports Administrator.

## Application Guidelines

**Process:** Application and possible interview.  
**Award:** Full or partial.  
**Deadline for applications:** Applications close at the end of Term 1.

Any scholarship awarded supersedes any existing discount, such as a sibling discount. Concessions are NOT cumulative. Whichever is the greater applies.

Short-listed applicants may be invited to an interview with the Principal and the Head of Secondary. Scholarships are awarded by the Principal. The value of the scholarship is at the Principal's discretion.

Applicants should submit the following documents to the Principal by the end of Term 1:

- Completed scholarship application form.
- An introductory letter written by the student stating why they would like to attend Bishop Druitt College (if applicable) and why they would make a worthy candidate for this scholarship.
- Copies of the student's last two school reports.
- A copy of the most recent NAPLAN results.
- Two current, relevant references supporting the application for a scholarship at Bishop Druitt College. References should be from local and representative coaches of the sport for which a scholarship award is sought.
- Any other supporting documentation of achievements in the areas of sport or co-curricular activities.
