COLLEGE UNIFORM POLICY

General Code

The Bishop Druit College uniform symbolises the pride we feel in our school. It has been developed in consultation with parents, fashion consultants and the Cancer Council of Australia, using quality materials that are both long-wearing and easy to care for. It is expected that all students will wear their uniform with pride.

Students must arrive at and depart from school in full uniform. Formal school uniform, which includes blazer and tie, is to be worn in winter. School jumpers are not to be worn tied around the waist.

We encourage students to wear a hat and sunscreen when they leave the protection of school buildings, at assemblies and all outdoor activities.

On sports days, the College tracksuit is optional. Under no circumstances can the tracksuit jacket be worn as a substitute for the woollen jumper.

If students have PE on days other than sport day, they must still wear their full school uniform to school and change at the appropriate time and change again, leaving the school in full uniform.

The footwear is black leather lace-up shoes – jogger styles are not permitted. When socks are worn, they must cover the ankles.

Correct uniform must be worn in public and when representing the school. When in formal uniform, the top button must be fastened and the tie must be over the top button. Girl's skirt should be worn to the knee.

No jewellery is to be worn, other than a watch and a single sleeper or small stud in base of the ear lobe. Boys are discouraged from wearing earrings. Christian emblems, in the form of a small simple cross, around the neck is acceptable.

Hair should be neat and clean. Extremes of hair styles and/or colours that cause comment are not permitted; any hair style or garish hair colour which is unusual enough to cause comment or draw attention to the wearer will be considered extreme. Undercuts and facial hair are not permitted. All hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back with a suitable navy blue or red tie.

Makeup, nail polish, nose studs or rings, glitter, stickers, bangles (arm and ankle) are not to be worn. Visible tattoos are banned. Year 12 Jackets may be worn on sports days and informal functions. Year 12 has a commemorative Jacket as part of their uniform.

COLLEGE UNIFORM ITEMS

Primary Girls

Dress, hat with emblem, jumper, short navy socks (in winter girls may wear navy tights), black leather lace-up shoes, ribbons, red scrunchies.

Sports: Culottes or shorts (navy knee length), shirt, white socks, white sports shoes, school tracksuit.

Primary Boys

Shirt, navy shorts (in winter boys may wear College trousers), hat (soft canvas with emblem), navy tie (worn in winter only), jumper, short navy socks, black leather lace-up shoes.

Sports: Navy shorts, shirt, white socks, white sports shoes, school tracksuit.

Junior Girls – Years 7-10

Formal/Winter: College blazer, navy skirt, winter shirt, tie, jumper, navy tights and leather lace-up shoes.

Casual/Summer: College unisex shirt (can be worn out), navy skirt, navy ankle socks and leather lace-up shoes, College broad brim hat available.

Sport: Sports top, shorts, joggers (predominantly white), white socks, cap.

Options: Girl's slacks, taslon sports tracksuit, sports cap, red scrunchie, bike pants (sport).

Junior Boys – Years 7-10

Formal/Winter: College blazer, winter shirt, navy trousers, tie, black belt, jumper, navy socks and leather lace-up shoes.

Casual/Summer: College – unisex shirt (can be worn out), navy shorts, black belt, navy socks, leather lace-up shoes.

Sport: Sports top, sports shorts, joggers (predominantly white), white socks, cap.

Options: Taslon sport tracksuit, sports cap.

Senior Girls – Years 11-12

All Year: College blazer, senior blouse, senior skirt, College badge, navy socks, senior tie, black leather lace-up shoes.

Winter: Regulation woollen jumper (with school crest – can be worn on cold days), navy stockings or tights.

Sport: Sports top, shorts, joggers (predominantly white), white socks, cap.

Options: Taslon sports tracksuit, sports cap, red scrunchie, bike pants (sport).

Senior Boys – Years 11-12

Winter: College blazer, shirt (short sleeve), College badge, navy socks, senior tie, belt (black), black leather lace-up shoes, trousers, woollen jumper (with school crest – can be worn on cold days).

Summer: Navy shorts.

Sport: Sports top, sports shorts, joggers (predominantly white), white socks, cap.

Options: Taslon sport tracksuit, sports cap.
